■ Prof. Dr. Michio Oishi



Dr. Oishi received his PhD in 1963 from the Department of Biochemistry and Biophysics, University of Tokyo. He started his professional career as a scientist at Princeton University in 1964, which was followed as a Member at the Public Health Research Institute of New York and Professor of New York University Medical School. He returned to Japan in 1979 as a Professor of the University of Tokyo, and became the Director of the Institute of Molecular and Cellular Bioscience of the University. In 1995, he was appointed to be the Director-General of the National Institute of Bioscience and Human Technology.

Dr. Oishi is currently the President of the Japan Bioindustry Organization, Director and Chairman of the Board of Trustee of Kazusa DNA Research Institute, and President of the National Bioscience Database Center. He has also been serving a number of governmental, academic and industrial positions including: Member of the Advisory Committee for Biotechnology to the Prime Minister, Member of the Board of Science and Technology Council (Life Science Division, Cabinet Office), Member of the Science Advisory Board of the Ministry of Health and Welfare, and the President of the Molecular Biology Society of Japan. He is a member of a number of international organizations including: Member of the Human Genome Organization, and Board Member of the African Agricultural Technology Foundation (AATF). He is also Professor Emeritus of the University of Tokyo.
